



1. Privacy at a glance

General information

The following notes give a simple overview of what happens to your personal information when you visit our website. Personal data is any data that personally identifies you. Detailed information on data protection can be found in our Privacy Policy.

Who is responsible for the data collection on this website?

The data processing on this website is carried out by the website operator. Its contact details can be found in the imprint of this website.

How do we collect your data?

Your data will be collected on the one hand, by telling us this. This may be z. B. order Act data that you enter in a contact form. Other data is collected automatically when visiting the website through our IT systems. These are above all technical data (eg Internet browser, operating system or time of the page request). The collection of this information is automatic as soon as you enter our website.

What do we use your data for?

Part of the data is collected to ensure a flawless provision of the website. Other Data can be used to analyze your user behavior.

What rights do you have regarding your data?

At any time you have the right to obtain free information about the origin, recipient and purpose of your stored personal data. You also have a right to request the correction, blocking or deletion of this data. Furthermore, you have a right of appeal to the competent supervisory authority. Revocation of your consent to data processing

Many data processing operations are only possible with your express consent. You can ... a consent given at any time. An informal message by e-mail to us is sufficient. The legality of the data processing carried out until the revocation remains unaffected by the revocation. Right to object to data collection in special cases and direct mail (Art. 21 DSGVO) If the data processing on the basis of Art. 6 para. 1 lit. e or f DSGVO, you have the right at any time to object to the processing of your personal data for reasons arising from your particular situation; this also applies to profiling based on these provisions. The respective legal basis on which a processing is based can be found in this privacy policy. If you file an objection, we will not process your personal information, unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for processing that outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing is for the purpose of enforcing, pursuing or defending legal claims (Opposition under Art. 21 (1) GDPR). If your personal information is being processed for direct mail, you have that Right, at any time objection to the processing of personal data relating to you To insert purposes of such advertising; this also applies to profiling insofar as it is associated with such direct mail. If you object, your personal data will then no longer be used for the purpose of direct advertising (objection under Art. 21 (2) GDPR).

Right of appeal to the competent supervisory authority

In the case of violations of the GDPR, the persons concerned have a right of appeal to a supervisory authority, in particular in the Member State of their habitual residence, their place of work or the place of the alleged infringement. The right to complain is without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedies.

Right to data portability

You have the right to obtain data based on your consent or in fulfillment of a contract automated, to be handed over to itself or to a third party in a common, machine-readable format. Unless you transfer the data directly to another person in charge request, this only takes place, as far as it is technically feasible.

SSL or TLS encryption

This site uses SSL or TLS for security reasons and to protect the transmission of confidential content, such as orders or requests that you send to us as a site operator encryption. Information, blocking, deletion and correction

You have the right to free of charge at any time within the scope of the applicable legal provisions Information about your stored personal data, their origin and recipient and the purpose of the data processing and possibly a right to correction, blocking or deletion of this data. Right to restriction of processing

You have the right to request the restriction of the processing of your personal data. You can contact us at any time at the address given in the imprint. The right to restriction of processing exists in the following cases:

- If you deny the accuracy of your personal information stored with us, we generally need time to verify this. For the duration of the audit you have the right to request the restriction of the processing of your personal data.
- If the processing of your personal data has been unlawful / can happen You request the restriction of data processing instead of deletion.
- If we no longer need your personal information, you will use it to exercise, Defending or claiming legal rights, you have the right to demand, instead of deletion, the restriction of the processing of your personal data..
- If you have filed an objection under Art. 21 (1) GDPR, a balance must be made between your interests and ours. As long as it is not clear whose interests prevail, you have the right to demand the restriction of the processing of your personal data.
- If you have restricted the processing of your personal information, other than your storage, such data may only be used with your consent or to assert, exercise or defend legal rights or protect the rights of another natural or legal person or for important public interest the European Union or a Member State.

Opposition to advertising emails

3. Data collection on our website

Cookies

The internet pages partly use so-called cookies. Cookies do not harm your computer and do not contain viruses. Cookies serve to make our offer more user-friendly, more effective and make it safer. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer and stored by your browser.

Most of the cookies we use are so-called „session cookies“. They will be after the end Your visit automatically deleted. Other cookies are stored on your device until you receive them Clear. Server log files

The provider of the pages automatically collects and stores information in so-called server log files. Files that your browser automatically sends to us. These are:

- Browser type and browser version
- used operating system
- Referrer URL
- Host name of the accessing computer
- Time of the server request
- IP-address

There is no merge of this data with other data sources. The collection of this data is based on Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f DSGVO. The website operator has a legitimate interest in the technically error-free presentation and the optimization of its website - for this purpose, the server log files must be recorded.

Inquiry by e-mail, or telephone

If you contact us by e-mail or telephone, your request, including all resulting personal data (name, request) will be stored and processed by us for the purpose of processing your request. We will not share this information without your consent. The processing of this data is based on Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b DSGVO, if your request is related to the performance of a contract or is required to carry out pre-contractual action. In all

other cases, the processing is based on your consent (Article 6 (1) a DSGVO) and / or on our legitimate interests (Article 6 (1) f DSGVO), since we have a legitimate interest in the effective Processing of requests addressed to us. The data sent by you to us via contact requests remain with us until you ask us to delete, revoke your consent to the storage or the purpose for the data storage is omitted (eg after completion of your request). Mandatory statutory provisions - in particular statutory retention periods - remain unaffected.

The legality of the already completed data processing operations remains unaffected by the revocation. The data deposited with us for the purpose of obtaining the newsletter will be stored by us from the newsletter until your cancellation and will be deleted after cancellation of the newsletter. Data stored for other purposes with us remain unaffected.
